

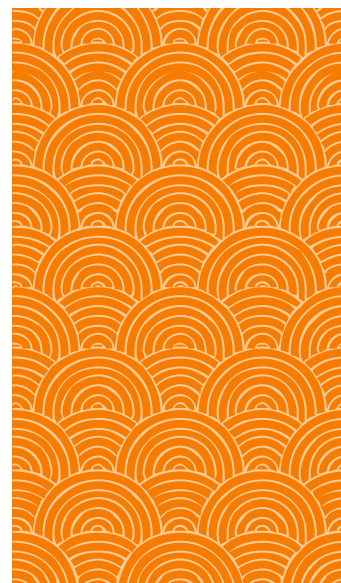
# Year 3 Classroom Clippings
